- Chreia Project
  - People in Crisis fund has been more of a handout rather than a hand up and needed to be changed.

- Providence School
  - They approached and asked to revisit their proposal to use the Concord Trinity facility for their school beginning in the Fall.
  - Our concerns including insurance, legal, values and space for church programming haven't changed but will meet with them.
- Pastor Report
  - o The staff is doing a great job of empowering volunteers.
  - The COOPS have gotten to the point where they need to consider dividing and growing.
  - Rev.Kim Jenne, from the conference office, will lead our first lunch and learn of the year in March.
  - Focus moving forward- Communication, Alignment, Promoting leaders.
- Parsonage roof
  - Roof needs repair. Have a quote from Tesson Roofing, will request a quote from CJS Roofing
- Insurance Coverage
  - Insuring a church is a specialized business. Brotherhood Mutual Insurance is increasing the premium +\$4,000 for Concord Trinity. The deductible is also being changed from \$5,000 to 1% of the insured value- potentially costing thousands of dollars. Gale will review and report out.
