# From the Desk of ... Pastor Mary Weaver

Hello Concord Trinity Friends!

I don't know about you, but I'm having a hard time believing it's September. Where did the summer go? I write this after I have already moved my oldest daughter back to college (go Tigers!) and I am about to move my youngest daughter to college for her first year (go Bulldogs!). And my guess is that all of your children or grandchildren have either started school or will be soon.

Schools starting up also means our children and youth programs here at the church are beginning. I don't think there's any doubt in anyone's mind how important our kids are and how important their faith development is. And we are so blessed now to have Samantha Fomera on board as our new Director of Family Ministry.

But I think you'd agree that it's not a one-person job; not even a handful-of-people job. We need volunteers to help facilitate, coach, teach, and walk alongside our children and youth as they grow in their faith.

If you believe that youth group is vital for our youth's faith journey, then volunteer! If you believe Sunday Morning Gatherings for our children is instrumental in their spiritual growth, then volunteer! We have so few volunteers that some of these activities won't be able to happen if there isn't more assistance.

If our mission is to make new disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world, the focus will remain on our newest disciples instead of the "already" disciples.

My prayer and hope is that if you are an "already" disciple, you can help serve and volunteer for our newest disciples!
